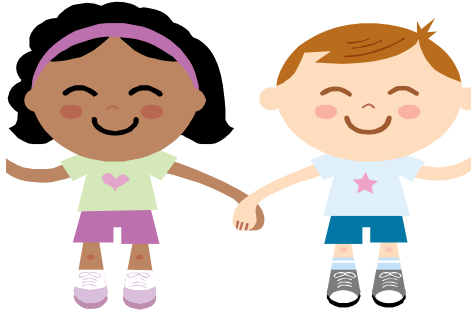

What Will We Learn This Month?

LANGUAGE ARTS

We're identifying and creating upper and lower case letters, exploring phonemic awareness, word segmentation and looking at what makes a word a word.

The sight words are: my, a, the, I, and like.

MATH—We are sorting, classifying, and identifying objects by their attributes. We are counting to 10 with corresponding values, and making graphs.

SCIENCE—We will be discovering the 5 senses

SOCIAL STUDIES—We will learn about school and class communities. We will also be learning about patriotic symbols starting with our flag.
